'NORTH COUNTRY STEAM' on the Conway Scenic Railroad

North Conway, NH to Hazens & Return with 0-6-0 Steam Engine 7470
Sunday, July 31, 2011 ONLY!!

Join Mass Bay RRE for a special *steam-powered* excursion through Crawford Notch to Hazens, the northernmost point on the Conway Scenic Railroad. This unique, one-day-only event will cover trackage of the former Maine Central Railroad "Mountain Division" not normally operated by the Conway Scenic with steam power. This will be the 7470's first trip to Hazens since she arrived at the Conway Scenic and the first steam-powered train to Hazens since 1953, when the last MEC steam powered train went through.

We'll depart from the landmark CSRR North Conway station at 10:00 AM. With 0-6-0 #7470 (built by the Grand Trunk Railroad in 1921) in the lead we will travel west through Intervale and Notchland, crossing the famed Frankenstein Trestle before arriving at Crawford Notch. After a water stop at the Notch we'll continue on through Fabyans to Hazens. We will then head east, returning to North Conway at approximately 7:30 PM. The trip will include multiple photo stops at scenic locations along the way to Hazens.

Our train will consist of two Conway Scenic coaches, an open-window coach, the First-Class car "Carroll P. Reed" and the dome car "Dorthea Mae". Climate-controlled First-Class seating in the "Carroll P. Reed" and the lower level of the dome car includes complimentary light snack and beverage service throughout the trip. A limited number of seats are available "under glass" in the dome section of the "Dorthea Mae", also including complimentary snacks & beverages (*extra fare & advance reservations required for seating in these cars - see order form below*). Mass Bay RRE members are eligible for discounted fares - see our web site for complete details of our member benefits policy.



The Boston Coach Connection

Our connecting motor coach service from Boston, leaving South Station at 6:45 AM and the Anderson RTC in Woburn at 7:00 AM, will offer a guaranteed connection with our train at North Conway for a one-way trip to Hazens. The coach will depart from Hazens shortly after our train's 4:00 arrival there and will visit the famed ball signal in Whitefield before heading back to Boston, making a dinner stop (individual settlement) en route. Return to Boston will be around 8:30 PM.

Train capacity is limited! We will assign seats by car only and will reserve blocks of seats for groups of four or more. Passengers wishing to sit together must order tickets together at the same time. 'Boxcar' lunches are available for advance purchase, or you may bring your own food. Also, the Conway Scenic snack counter on board will offer sandwiches, snack and hot & cold beverage service.

This trip operates ONE DAY ONLY, rain, snow or shine. All sales are final and tickets are not refundable. Alcoholic beverages and smoking will not be permitted aboard this train. Tickets will be mailed to you about 10 days prior to the trip; we will send driving directions to the departure point in North Conway with your tickets. Please notify us if special accommodations (handicap seating, etc.) are required.
